Financial Action Task Force **Non-cooperative Countries and Territories ("NCCTs")**

The Financial Action Task Force on Money Laundering ("FATF") has recently removed Cook Islands, Indonesia and the Philippines from the list of NCCTs having regard to the significant progress they made in improving their anti-money laundering regimes. Jurisdictions remaining on the list of NCCTs are Myanmar, Nauru and Nigeria.

You are advised to give special attention to the businesses and transactions with persons, including companies and financial institutions, in the above NCCTs, in accordance with Recommendation 21^(Note).

Recommendation 21: Financial institutions should give special attention to business relations and transactions with persons, including companies and financial institutions, from countries which do not or insufficiently apply the FATF Recommendations.
