Revised GN3 - Guidance Note on <u>Prevention of Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing</u>

I refer to the Guidance Note on Prevention of Money Laundering issued to you on 7 December 2000 ("former Guidance Note") which sets out the principles, practices and measures that should be adopted by the insurance industry to combat money laundering.

In light of operational experience and international development, the Insurance Authority has revised the Guidance Note in consultation with the insurance industry and other relevant bodies. The revised Guidance Note is renamed "Guidance Note on Prevention of Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing ("Guidance Note")", which supercedes the former Guidance Note as well as the Supplement to the Guidance Note on Prevention of Money Laundering and Guideline on the Combat of Terrorist Financing issued on 25 June 2003. A copy of the <u>Guidance Note</u> is attached. Please note that the Guidance Note is also available for downloading from the website of this office at <u>http://www.info.gov.hk/oci</u>.

To allow time for you to make changes to your existing procedures and systems, the Guidance Note shall take effect from 1 July 2006. You should therefore review and revise your current policies and procedures in the prevention of money laundering and terrorist financing so as to comply with the Guidance Note as soon as possible, and in any event not later than 30 June 2006. Before you are able to comply with this Guidance Note, you should continue to comply with the former Guidance Note.

For your information, a booklet version of the Guidance Note, which will be printed in both Chinese and English, is under preparation and will be sent to you when available.
