Dear Sirs,

Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing Risks Associated with Virtual Commodities

We refer to our circular of 29 January 2014 to you giving guidance on measures to mitigate the money laundering and terrorist financing ("ML/TF") risks associated with virtual commodities such as Bitcoin, and the recent press statement issued by the Hong Kong Government on 14 March 2014 warning the public of various risks associated with any trading or dealing in virtual commodities which we have brought to your attention on the same date.

In the above connection, we would like to remind you again to exercise increased vigilance commensurate with ML/TF risks associated with virtual commodities. In particular, you should exercise caution in assessing relevant ML/TF risks when establishing or maintaining business relationships with potential or existing customers who are operators of schemes or businesses related to virtual commodities¹, and take additional customer due diligence measures and perform enhanced ongoing monitoring of activities of any such customer to detect suspicious transactions. You should also be mindful of your statutory duty to report suspicious transactions to the Joint Financial Intelligence Unit.
