## **United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Ordinance United States Executive Order 13224**

We are writing to inform you of the following developments:

#### (i) United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Ordinance

An updated list of terrorists and terrorist associates designated by the United Nations Security Council Committee ("Committee") has been specified under the United Nations (Anti-Terrorism Measures) Ordinance ("UNATMO"). The list has been published in the Gazette (G.N. 2937) on 24 April 2015 and is available on the Government's website <a href="http://www.gld.gov.hk/egazette/">http://www.gld.gov.hk/egazette/</a>. Relevant press release issued by the Committee is attached at the Appendix for your reference.

Please note that under section 8 of the UNATMO, a person must not (a) except under the authority of a licence granted by the Secretary for Security, make any property or financial (or related) services available, by any means, directly or indirectly, to or for the benefit of a person knowing that, or being reckless as to whether, the person is a terrorist or terrorist associate; or (b) collect property or solicit financial (or related) services by any means, directly or indirectly, for the benefit of a person knowing that, or being reckless as to whether, the person is a terrorist or terrorist associate.

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#### (ii) <u>United States Executive Order 13224</u>

The US Government updated the list of individuals and entities designated under the US Executive Order 13224 on 21 April 2015. The relevant information can be found on the website of the US Treasury <a href="http://www.treasury.gov/resource-center/sanctions/Programs/Documents/terror.pdf">http://www.treasury.gov/resource-center/sanctions/Programs/Documents/terror.pdf</a>.

You should review your records carefully to see whether you have had, or currently have, accounts, transactions or dealings with the named individuals or entities. If such review reveals any suspicious accounts, transactions or dealings, you should promptly notify the Joint Financial Intelligence Unit. You are also reminded to browse the US Treasury's website (including the FinCEN's website) regularly for the latest information.

## Security Council Al-Qaida Sanctions Committee Adds Two Names to Its Sanctions List

SECURITY COUNCIL PRESS RELEASE

On 10 April 2015, the Security Council Committee pursuant to resolutions 1267 (1999) and 1989 (2011) approved the addition of the entries specified below to its Al-Qaida Sanctions List of individuals and entities subject to the assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo set out in paragraph 1 of Security Council resolution 2161 (2014) adopted under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations:
