Second Readiness Assessment Survey on Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard 17 Insurance Contracts

I am writing to invite you to participate in the Second Readiness Assessment Survey on the implementation of Hong Kong Financial Reporting Standard 17 ("HKFRS 17").

In September 2018, we conducted a Readiness Assessment Survey to understand the preparation status of authorized insurers and their challenges in implementing the standard¹. We have received positive feedback on the initiative and also observe progressive move of the industry in implementing HKFRS 17.

On 26 June 2019, the International Accounting Standards Board ("IASB") published the Exposure Draft of proposed amendments to International Financial Reporting Standard 17 ("IFRS 17") to respond to concerns and challenges raised by stakeholders. The Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants ("HKICPA") also conducts public consultation on those IASB proposals for comments by 19 August 2019.²
