iAM Smart Pilot Sandbox Programme

iAM Smart is one of the Government's newest innovation initiatives to facilitate Hong Kong residents transacting online with the Government and commercial entities by enabling them to use a single unique electronic identity. Hong Kong residents can register and use iAM Smart free of charge and on a voluntary basis. This new initiative is scheduled to be launched in the fourth quarter of this year. Upon its launch, over 20 commonly used online government services will be supporting iAM Smart. It is expected that by mid-2021, residents can access about 110 online government services through iAM Smart.

To enable commercial organisations to get better prepared for the adoption of iAM Smart in the future, Cyberport, in collaboration with the Government, initiated the iAM Smart Pilot Sandbox Programme to facilitate interested organisations of the financial sector to conduct mock-up tests on various functions of the iAM Smart through its Application Programming Interfaces ("APIs") provided by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer ("OGCIO"). Cyberport will work with OGCIO to provide technical assistance on the APIs. Participants may also offer their comments and suggestions on iAM Smart through this programme.

The Programme will be open until the end of this year tentatively. You can find a brief introduction of the iAM Smart and the Programme at Cyberport's YouTube Channel <u>https://youtu.be/cMRILBafn0U</u> with both Chinese and English subtitles.
