Subject: Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Programme

Prior to the new CPD requirements becoming effective on 1 August 2005, Registered Persons are provided with the flexibility in choosing the activities to earn CPD core credits. Effective 15 March 2005 to 31 July 2005, qualified activities for earning CPD hours will also apply to those for earning CPD core credits and vice versa. That is to say, core credit earning activities (related to local insurance (or related) legislation and the regulatory aspects of insurance practice in Hong Kong) will now cover structured activities related to local insurance (or related) legislation, regulatory aspects of insurance practice in Hong Kong, insurance, actuarial science, risk management, financial planning, or other disciplines which are directly related to the work of insurance intermediaries, such as investment, law and legal knowledge, finance, business, commerce, management, engineering or communication skills, as described in paragraph 8 of the CPD Information Sheet dated January 2005 issued by the IA.

All these CPD activities must be accredited by the accreditation authority for the CPD Programme (i.e. the Hong Kong Council for the Academic Accreditation) unless otherwise specified.

Please note that other than the above arrangement, all other information in the CPD Information Sheets respectively dated December 2004 and January 2005 issued by the IA remain valid, in particular:

- Registered Persons are required to earn 5 core and 10 non-core credits annually up to 31 July 1. 2005; and
- From 1 August 2005, Registered Persons are required to earn 10 CPD hours every year. 2.
