The Insurance Authority informed The Hong Kong Federation of Insurers that the Steering Committee of the Insurance Intermediaries Quality Assurance Scheme had recently agreed the addition of a newly recognized professional qualification, namely the HKSI Professional Diploma in Financial Markets of the Hong Kong Securities Institute ("PDFM"), to the exemption list of the Investment-linked Long Term Insurance Examination.

As approved by the Insurance Authority, the attached addenda of *the Code of Practice for the Administration of Insurance Agents* are hereby issued to reflect such addition.
