Key Responsibilities

- Handle telephone and written complaints against insurers and intermediaries professionally
- Carry out assessment and prepare assessment reports on alleged complaint and noncompliance cases
- Communicate and follow up with complainants, insurers and intermediaries professionally
- Manage the Complaint System
- Prepare monthly management information on complaints
- Conduct trend and root cause analyses on complaints to identify any industry issues
- Communicate regulatory considerations / expectations with insurers and intermediaries
- Liaise with other regulatory bodies on complaint and non-compliance cases

Requirements

- A Bachelor's degree, professional qualification in finance, insurance, economics, laws, accounting, or related disciplines
- Minimum 3 years' relevant work experience in complaint handling / audit / compliance / risk management with insurance companies, other regulatory organizations or financial institutions
- Knowledge of local regulatory requirement, preferably in the insurance sector
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills in English and Chinese; proficiency in Putonghua will be an advantage
- Strong analytical skill; self-confident and empathetic skills in dealing with stakeholders including complainants, insurers and insurance intermediaries
- Self-motivated, mature, patient and able to work under pressure
- Strong interpersonal skills and be a good team player
